Step 2: Click on 'Sign Up for a Meal Plan.' You will be directed to the UMary Portal

Step 3: Click on 'Meal Plans' then 'Dining Plans.'

Step 4: Click on 'Change Dining Plan' and select your plan

Step 5: Click 'Submit'

MEAL PLAN FAQs

Who is required to purchase a meal plan? All residents in Traditional or Suite-style Residence Halls are required to purchase a Traditional Meal Plan. All residents in the Apartment Communities are required to purchase a qualifying Block Meal Plan. Additionally, all scholar athletes on athletic scholarships who do not live on campus are required to purchase any meal plan. If a meal plan is required and no plan is chosen by the first day of classes, plans will be defaulted to the Sapphire Meal Plan. Commuter students may purchase any meal plan.

Can I change my meal plan? Students may change their meal plan option prior to the close of business on the first day of classes; these changes may be made online on the housing portal. After the first day of classes, students who wish to change their meal plan will need to do so by emailing dining@umary.edu. After Monday, September 16, ten business days after the start of the semester, students will be unable to change to a lesser plan. However, students may upgrade or add the Golden Ticket throughout the year. Meal plan changes will be billed according to the date of change on a prorated basis.

Can I use my meal plan for friends or family? Students may use their Guest Passes or Marauders Bucks to treat friends and family to a meal in the Crow's Nest Campus Restaurant. Marauders Bucks may also be used to treat guests at Marauders Cove. Other options are to use Universal Bucks, or Credit Card. Unlimited or block meal swipes are for personal use only and some restrictions may apply.

What are the dates of service under my fall 2024 Meal Plan? Under the terms of each plan, 24-hour meal service will begin for students at 4 pm on Sunday, September 1, 2024. Meal service will end at 1 pm on Wednesday, December 18, 2024. In case of inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances, hours and services may vary.

What are Marauders Bucks? Marauders Bucks may come with the purchase of a meal plan. Marauders Bucks can be used to make purchases at the Crow's Nest Campus Restaurant, Marauders Cove, all campus vending machines, the concession stand in the McDowell Activity Center, and

the University Bookstore. Additional Marauders Bucks cannot be added, but Universal Bucks can be added and used in the same way. All Marauders Bucks must be used by the end of the semester. Unused Marauders Bucks are not refundable and cannot be rolled over.

What are Universal Bucks? Universal Bucks are dollars that can be added to a student's account and be used to make purchases at the Crow's Nest Campus Restaurant, Marauders Cove, all campus vending machines, the concession stand in the McDowell Activity Center, and the University Bookstore. Universal Bucks can be rolled over from semester to semester. Additional Universal Bucks can be added by visiting the Business Office in the Benedictine Center or by phone with a credit card at 701-355-8249.

What are the hours for Fall Break and Thanksgiving?

During Fall Break, the Crow's Nest will have limited hours for those students that choose to stay on campus for meals. Fall Break is October 18-20. For Thanksgiving, the Crow's Nest will close on November 27 at 7 pm and remain closed until December 1 at 4 pm. For those students that choose to remain on campus, there will be a special Thanksgiving Banquet on November 28 with Monsignor Shea and a film festival. At the meal, you will receive a care package.
