TRIO and Nursing students teamed up to help Ministry on the Margins for the campus wide Day of Service. Together they cleaned and organized the facilities new intake room!



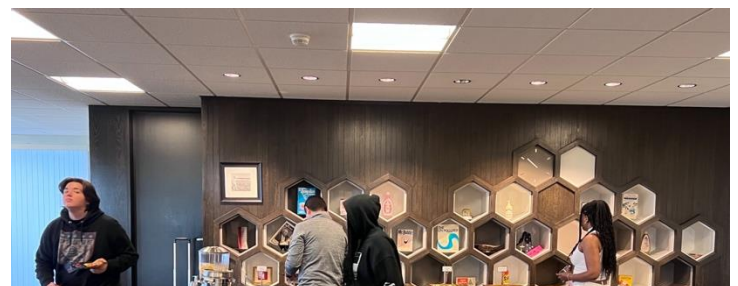
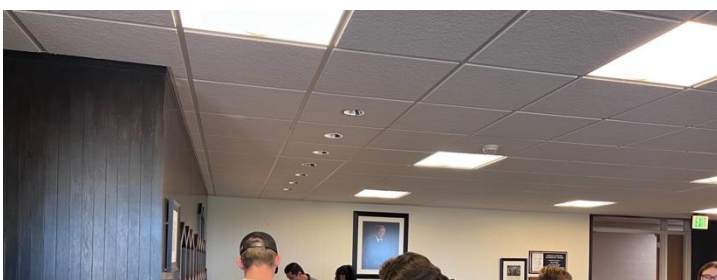
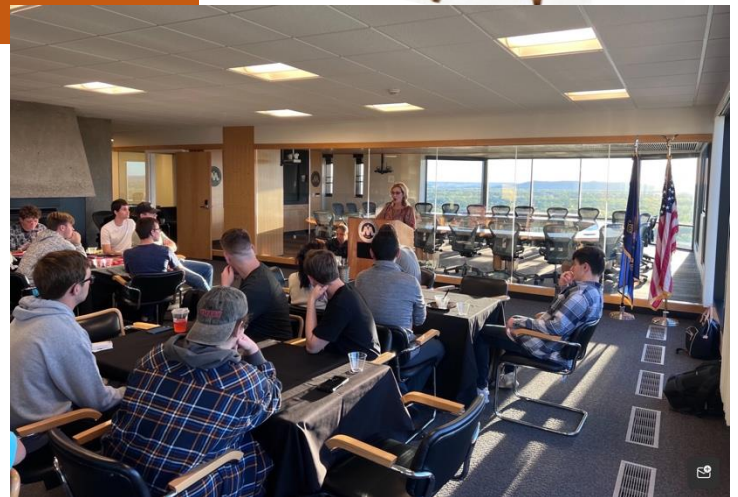

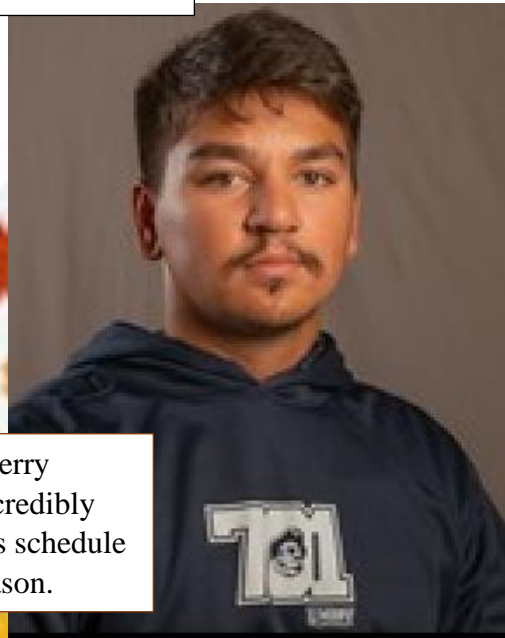


# TRIO's Wall of Fame!

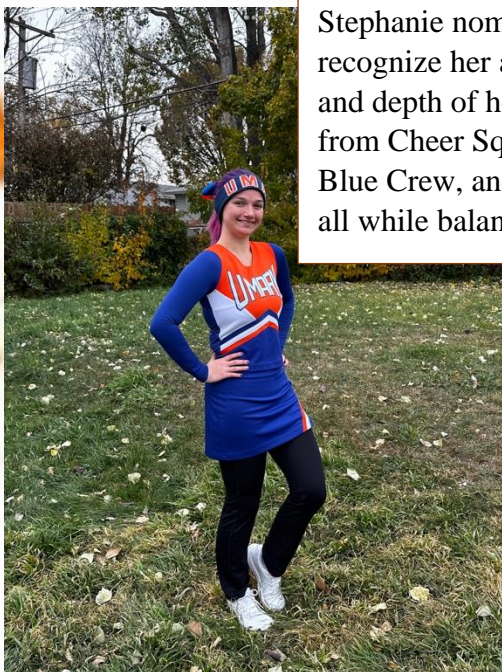
RECOGNIZING EXCEPTIONAL STUDENTS!!

Jennifer nominated Joe Terry because he is working incredibly hard to balance a rigorous schedule with his busy football season.



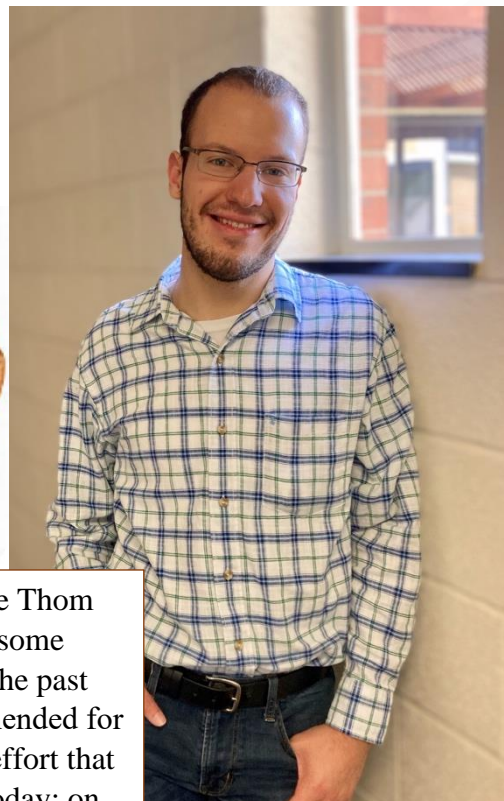

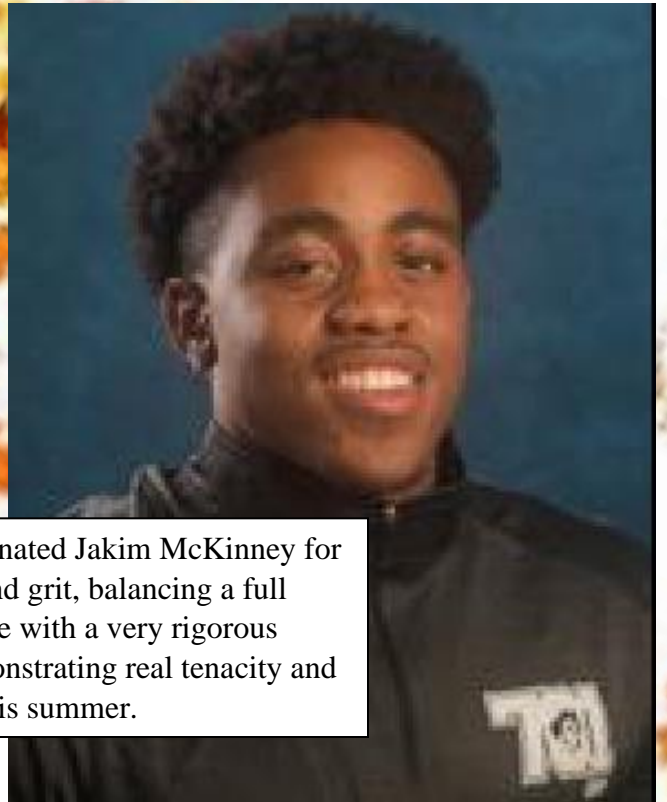


Kristi nominated Ariel Arriaga for several reasons: her kind heart, her incredible work ethic and her passion for learning. Congratulations Ariel!
